### WHAT HAPPENS AT BAPTISM?

At Baptism, through the pouring of water and anointing with Chrism, the child becomes a member of the Church.

Baptism is only a beginning. It will be the duty and privilege of parents to help their child grow up in the knowledge, love and grace of God. For the seed of faith sown in Baptism to flourish, it needs their love and care. The way parents live, the way they love each other, their attitude and beliefs, their worship at Mass each week and the prayer they say, morning and evening, will all contribute to their child's experience of what it means to be Christian—to grow up in the love of God.
