THE RELICS OF ST TERESA (MOTHER TERESA) OF CALCUTTA
Veneration in the Cathedral on Sat July 8th from after the 6.15pm Vigil Mass to 10pm (ending with Night Prayer) & Sun July 9th from after the 12 noon Mass to 8pm (ending with Night Prayer).

Mother Teresa was the founder of the Order of the Missionaries of Charity, a Roman Catholic congregation of women dedicated to helping the poor. Considered one of the greatest humanitarians of the 20th century, she was canonized as Saint Teresa of Calcutta in 2016.
Some of Mother Teresa's wisdom: "We think sometimes that poverty is only being hungry, naked and homeless. The poverty of being unwanted, unloved and uncared for is the greatest poverty. We must start in our own homes to remedy this kind of poverty." "Let us touch the dying, the poor, the lonely and the unwanted according to the graces we have received and let us not be ashamed or slow to do the humble work."
"There is always the danger that we may just do the work for the sake of the work. This is where the respect and the love and the devotion come in - that we do it to God, to Christ, and that's why we try to do it as beautifully as possible."

TRÓCAIRE EAST AFRICA FAMINE APPEAL As you know, prolonged drought has led to severe food shortages across East Africa. Approximately 25 million people are in need of emergency assistance. Trócaire in South Sudan, Kenya and Ethiopia focuses on food and water, while in Somalia they are also running health clinics treating people for malnutrition, cholera and other associated health issues. To help with this lifesaving work, there will be a special collection on July 22nd and 23rd.
