BAPTISM TALKS FOR PARENTS: While parents can be busy planning for the day of Baptism itself, they need the opportunity to reflect themselves on what baptism is, and what it means for them and their child. With this in mind, Killarney Parish has formed a Baptismal Preparation Team, and all parents planning a baptism are now asked to attend an evening of reflection about baptism. Details will be given when they book the baptism with the Parish Office. We pray that as a community we may do our best to help parents hand on the Catholic faith to their child.

WHAT SHOULD I LOOK FOR IN GODPARENTS? They should be at least 16 years of age, one male and one female, Catholic, and have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. They should be people who are alive in their faith - practicing their faith in Mass each week, in prayer each day, and in good living throughout their lives. If a parent was looking for their child to play a sport or a musical instrument, the parent would choose a coach or tutor who lives and loves the activity. So also in choosing a Godparent. Choose well, choose wisely, and choose the best people to assist in handing on the faith to your child.
