## THE FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION

Monday August 15th is the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is a Holy Day of Obligation.

**About the Feast Day:** The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary commemorates that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory - a foretaste of our own bodily resurrection at the end of time. Because it signifies the Blessed Virgin's passing into eternal life, it is a most important feast day and a holy day of obligation.

**About a Holy Day:** On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are to refrain from engaging in work so as to: worship God at Mass; celebrate the joy proper to the Lord's Day or the Feast Day; engage in works of mercy; and enjoy the appropriate rest of mind and body.

(Please note that there will not be Sunday evening Vigil Masses for the Holy Day, but there is the Monday evening Mass at 6.15pm)

### **SACRED SPACE IN THE CATHEDRAL DEDICATED TO OUR LADY:**

St Mary's Cathedral is dedicated to Our Lady of the Assumption, her feast day being Aug 15th, and the feast day of the dedication of the Cathedral is on Aug 22nd. Marking both of these, there is a sacred space to our Lady of the Assumption in place in the Cathedral near our Lady's Altar, which you might like to visit and pray there for yourself and your loved ones, asking for the prayerful intercession of our heavenly Mother.

**PARKING AT THE CATHEDRAL:** At Mass times we remind you again of the parking at the Cathedral sacristy door to be reserved for those who need the wheelchair ramp, and to keep the parking on the Cathedral grounds for those who are less mobile and need to park close by for a shorter walk. Outside of Mass times, the grounds and Bishop's path are for short term parking for worshippers and visitors.

**PARKING AT THE CHURCH OF THE RESURRECTION:** We ask everyone to always park in the car spaces only, and not on the yellow lines, footpaths or lanes. Safety of pedestrians and the access of emergency vehicles has been severely compromised over the last while due to poor parking and we all need to be vigilant to this.
