DIAMOND JUBILEE ORDINATION CELEBRATION: On June 19th Canon Pat Horgan marks 60 years of Priesthood, being ordained in 1955. His ministry in education saw him for 21 years in St Brendan's College here in Killarney, and afterwards as President of St Michael's College in Listowel, while his parish ministry in earlier years took him to England, Rathmore, Moyvane, Ballyferriter, and then as parish priest to Our Lady and St Brendan's in Tralee, and in Rathmore. His generosity in ministry continued after his retirement, with his service of God and God's people here in Killarney over the last number of years. This is a most wonderful commitment by him, and we, as a parish, celebrate with him and extend our gratitude. **On Friday June 19th, Canon Pat will celebrate the morning Mass at 9.30am in the Church of the Resurrection, and afterwards there will be refreshments in the parish centre beside the Church, to which all are warmly invited.** (You might kindly note that Fr Pat does not wish this to be a time of gift-giving to himself, but a time of thanksgiving to God).

PARKING AT ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL: We ask for your understanding when parking at the Cathedral, as access for some people is being impeded. On wet days, we all try to park as close as we can so as not to get wet, but others *need* to park closer due to mobility issues. At the Sacristy door of the Cathedral there is an access ramp for the use of those using a wheelchair or a mobility aid.

Parking At Mass Times: We ask that the parking around the Sacristy door be used only by those who need to use the wheelchair ramp. There are others who are of limited mobility and cannot walk a long distance from their cars to the Cathedral. **We ask that the parking on the grounds of the Cathedral only be used by those with limited mobility.**

Parking outside of Mass Times: Over the last while there has been an increase of cars parking on the Cathedral grounds for prolonged periods of time on weekdays, some for a few hours, others for the whole day. This has meant that there hasn't been sufficient parking available for people coming to Morning Mass, or for those coming for a funeral or wedding. We remind you that the nearby car park can be used for prolonged parking, and ask that the parking on the Cathedral grounds be left for visitors to the Cathedral. Please note that access to the grounds is now restricted in the morning time until just before morning Mass. Thank you for your understanding and help with this
