FUNERALS IN THE DIOCESE OF KERRY: From Diocesan
communications through the media over the last few months you will
be aware that from the 1st September 2017, there will unfortunately be
no funerals (Mass, Liturgy or burial) on a Sunday in the parishes of the
diocese.

- This change is necessary for many reasons: related to good Liturgy;
related to factors in individual parishes; and related to the availability
of priests;
- This applies from Saturday mid-afternoon; Removals to the church
can take place on either Saturday or Sunday evening;
- This will apply to Christmas Day and St Patrick's Day also. On the
other Holy Days of Obligation for flexibility reasons the decision is left
to the local parish (while discouraging such funerals for liturgical
reasons);
- Parishes are reminded that there will be no exceptions to this
diocesan regulation;

" I realise many will have reservations about this decision. It has been
taken after extensive consultation with laity and clergy throughout the
diocese" Bishop Ray Browne.

ENVELOPES We are most grateful to everyone for their contribution to

heat the Churches and parish buildings ensuring that they are
welcoming places for prayer. Your generosity and support also helps to

But did you know that using the box of Parish Envelopes can bear
even greater fruit for the parish, at no extra cost to you? Because the
parish has charitable status, we are able to avail from the Revenue
Commissioners of the Scheme for Tax Relief for Donations. This
means that for tax payers who use the parish envelopes and contribute
€250 or more, the parish is able to contact the Revenue
Commissioners for a tax rebate on the contribution, at no cost to the
individual. In real terms this amounted to €26,118, just from returning
the signed forms. Thanks to all who did so, and we ask all who use the
parish envelopes and contributed more than €250 to consider this as it
would help the parish further. Your continued generosity is greatly
appreciated. If you do not already have a box of envelopes, please
