**PARKING AT ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL:** We ask for your understanding when parking for Mass at the Cathedral, as access for some people has been impeded over the last while. On wet winter days, we all try to park as close as we can so as not to get wet, but others *need* to park closer due to mobility issues. At the Sacristy door of the Cathedral there is an access ramp for the use of those using a wheelchair or a mobility aid. **We ask that the parking around the Sacristy door be used only by those who need to use the wheelchair ramp.** There are others who are of limited mobility and cannot walk a long distance from their cars to the Cathedral. **We ask that the parking on the grounds of the Cathedral only be used by those with limited mobility.** Thank you for your understanding and help with this, especially over the Christmas Masses ahead.
