**WE HAVE A NEW PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL:** Over the past number of months, the parish has formed a new Parish Pastoral Council, a leadership group through which priests and people work together in planning the way forward in our parish. This is done by looking at the ongoing needs of our parishioners, looking at areas that need development, supporting the faith of parishioners, supporting young people in their faith and looking at ways that enable others to become more active within the parish. Our new Pastoral Council, is a representative body in which the diversity of the parish community is reflected. Our 12 new members recently attended two training evenings with Fr. Ger Godley, looking at the role and function of a Parish Pastoral Council and how we might identify priorities over the next while.

**NEW ENCYCLICAL FROM POPE FRANCIS: 'LAUDATO SI':** Pope Francis on Thursday called for a radical transformation of politics, economics and individual lifestyles to confront environmental degradation and climate change. The most vulnerable victims are the world's poorest people, he declared, who are being dislocated and disregarded. "Climate change is a global problem with grave implications: environmental, social, economic, political and for the distribution of goods," he wrote. "It represents one of the principal challenges facing humanity of our day".
