### 4th WEEK OF LENT: Penance

**Mon:** There is more rejoicing over one repentant sinner...  
**Tues:** Remember those who struggle to receive forgiveness.  
**Wed:** Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us  
**Thurs:** Pray for those who have suffered because of our sin  
**Fri:** With God there is mercy and fullness of redemption  
**Sat:** Pray for those who struggle to forgive
