PARKING AT ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL: In past newsletters we drew your attention to the parking on the Cathedral grounds. Over the last while there has been an increase of cars parked on the Cathedral grounds for prolonged periods of time on weekdays, some for a few hours, others for the whole day. This meant that families were unable to get parking as they came to the Cathedral at the time of funerals, weddings etc. Please note that parking is now restricted during the weekdays, and will of course be available for funerals, weddings etc. We remind you that the nearby car park continues to be available for parking.

Parking At Mass Times: We ask that the parking around the Sacristy door be used only by those who need to use the wheelchair ramp. There are others who are of limited mobility and cannot walk a long distance from their cars to the Cathedral. We ask that the parking on the grounds of the Cathedral at weekend Mass times only be used by those with limited mobility. Thank you for your understanding and help with this.
