## FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD: MON FEB

**2ND** is the Feast remembering Jesus being brought to the Temple by Mary and Joseph, and their encounter with Simeon who pronounces Jesus as 'the Light to reveal God to the nations'. With this image in mind, the Church marks the day also as Candlemas Day when we bless candles that will be lit over the time ahead for liturgy and the Eucharist. **Blessing of Candles** will take place at the 9.30 am Mass in the Church of the Resurrection and 10.30am Mass in St Mary's Cathedral on Mon.

**FEAST OF ST. BLAISE - TUE FEB 3RD:** Tradition has it that St Blaise was approached by a distraught mother whose only child was choking on a fishbone and she threw herself at his feet and implored his intercession. Touched at her grief, he offered up his prayers, and the child was cured. Consequently, Saint Blaise is invoked for protection against injuries and illnesses of the throat. Blessing of the throats will be available after all Masses in the parish on Tuesday.
