JAN 6TH IS THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (the Magi) from the East, representatives of the neighbouring pagan religions. The Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord concludes the Christmas season, and it is a Holy Day of obligation, with the following Mass times:
