STATEMENT FROM BISHOP RAY REGARDING THE UPCOMING

ELECTION: "A General Election is a unique event in the life of any country. The excitement and the hustle and bustle will be with us over the next few days until Election Day. It is good for our democracy that so many people participate in the campaign. Each makes a contribution to the strength of our democracy. Best wishes to every election candidate. I urge everyone to cast their vote." Regarding the 8th Amendment, Bishop Ray says: "Abortion is an issue that is highly sensitive for many, many people. It is not just an issue in Ireland. There are and will always be, in every country in the world, people of all faiths and none who will campaign against it. Christian people will always say 'no' to abortion". As a final word: "A key Gospel phrase comes to mind, "love one another, as I have loved you". How often in the Gospel Jesus looked after the poor and the needy and urged his followers to do the same. A healthy wholesome country is one in which there is a basic civic spirit of care for all fellow citizens, especially the sick, the poor and the vulnerable. This is our Christian desire for Ireland. Draw strength from the example of all those who have served our country so well in the hundred years since the 1916 Easter Rising which we commemorate this year.
