HAVE YOUR SAY IN THE CONSULTATION IN RELATION TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF A CURRICULUM IN EDUCATION ABOUT RELIGIONS, BELIEFS AND ETHICS IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS

The National Council for Curriculum and Assessment ("NCCA") has published a consultation paper in relation to the development of a curriculum in Education about Religions, Beliefs and Ethics ("ERBE") in all primary schools. The NCCA are proposing a number of approaches to the curriculum development. It is difficult to see how some of these approaches will work in a Catholic school context and there are concerns that existing religious education will be impacted. The NCCA are seeking submissions in relation to ERBE. There are two ways of submitting views to the NCCA; one is by completing the questionnaire on the NCCA website (www.ncca.ie) and the other is by making written submissions. The questionnaire is limited in scope and, therefore, written submissions are encouraged. The closing date for submissions is 31st March 2016.
