Each Week we will have a different theme as we try to deepen our faith commitment . This week we focus on STATIONS OF THE CROSS. The following might be helpful for your own private prayer and reflection, as well as a focus in our Masses for the time ahead.

### 3RD WEEK OF LENT: Focusing on Stations of the Cross

**Mon:** Jesus is condemned to death  
Jesus takes up his Cross

Jesus falls for the first time.

**Tues:** Jesus meets his Mother  
Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus  
Veronica wipes the face of Jesus

**Wed:** Jesus falls for the second time  
Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem  
Jesus falls for a third time

**Thurs:** Jesus is stripped of his clothes  
Jesus is nailed to the Cross

**Fri:** Jesus dies on the Cross  
Jesus is taken down from the Cross

Jesus is laid in the tomb

**Sat:** Jesus is raised from the dead.
