WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES - the outline of the three-day Pastoral Congress is now available on the website www.worldmeeting2018.ie. The Congress will run from 22-24 August in the RDS, Dublin and is packed with major panels, workshops, testimonies, cultural events and music performances throughout each day. The Congress will include the daily celebration of the Eucharist.
