frequency, it needs a special radio to receive it, which can be purchased
from the Parish Office. We also have **webcams in the Cathedral
broadcasting the Mass** over the internet on
www.killarneyparish.com, and is great for people living away, as well as
those unable to get to Mass. It is also possible to get this on your own
television, but you will need to have broadband internet in your home, and
a special set-top box, again which can be purchased from the Parish
Office, and which family members might be able to arrange.

ahead, or take them to someone who is sick or housebound and is unable
to get to Mass. We would appreciate if you could take any remaining
