Each Week we will have a different theme as we try to deepen our faith commitment. This week we focus on STATIONS OF THE CROSS. The following might be helpful for your own private prayer and reflection, as well as a focus in our Masses for the time ahead.

3RD WEEK OF LENT: Focusing on Stations of the Cross

Mon: Jesus is condemned to death, Jesus takes up his Cross, Jesus falls for the first time.

Tues: Jesus meets his Mother, Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus, Veronica wipes the face of Jesus

Wed: Jesus falls for the second time, Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem

Jesus falls for a third time

Thurs: Jesus is stripped of his clothes, Jesus is nailed to the Cross

Fri: Jesus dies on the Cross, Jesus is taken down from the Cross, Jesus is laid in the tomb

Sat: Jesus is raised from the dead
