THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD : JANUARY 6TH

The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (the Magi) from the East, representatives of the neighbouring pagan religions. The Feast concludes the Christmas season, and it is a Holy Day of obligation, with the following Mass times:

2025 A JUBILEE YEAR IN THE CHURCH.

A Jubilee Year is held every twenty-five years. Pope Francis officially opened Jubilee 2025 at Christmas Eve Mass with the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter's Basilica, in Rome. Pope Francis has chosen the Jubilee theme 'Pilgrims of Hope' which he says should be a year of hope for all God's pilgrim people and that all would experience the great gift of God's grace which brings life and grace to all humanity. We are asked to treat the year ahead as a year-long pilgrimage seeking together to become more aware that truly Jesus Christ Our Saviour is with us each day - as our help, strength and guide. When we speak of 'Hope' we mean 'Hope in Jesus Christ', Hope in our God, Father, Son and Spirit.
