BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS CANONISATION; On Sunday 27th April 2025 Blessed Carlo Acutis will be canonised in St Peter's Basilica in Rome. Bishop Ray Browne has very kindly accepted an invitation to mark this occasion by celebrating the 11.30am mass in the Franciscan Friary Killarney.

There will be an opportunity to venerate his first class relic immediately after the mass and again after the Holy Hour which starts at 6pm that evening.

As many of you know, Carlo had a great devotion to St Francis of Assisi and his tomb is in Assisi within walking distance of the tombs of St Francis and St Clare.
