From the moment he chose the name Francis, following in the footsteps of Francis of Assisi, rooted in humility he signalled a papacy of building peace, care for the poor, and love for all of God's creation. He constantly emphasised the need for all of us to take care of our planet, our common home. Like St Francis he alerted us to the "Cry of the Earth" and "Cry of the Poor", all creation united by the love of the Creator. Pope Francis ever sought to be a voice for the voiceless, a champion of mercy, and a witness to the Gospel in word and deed, always on the side of those on the margins. He preached and lived God's Mercy for all. In his Urbi et Orbi address on Easter Sunday, his final day among us, Pope Francis gave us these prophetic words:"The Resurrection of Jesus is indeed the basis of our hope. For in the light of this event, hope is no longer an illusion Thanks to Christ — crucified and risen from the dead — hope does not disappoint! (cf. Rom 5:5) All those who put their hope in God place their feeble hands in his strong and mighty hand; they let themselves be raised up and set out on a journey. Together with the
